

# UC DAVIS AGGIES INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS



UC Davis sponsors 14 varsity sports for women and 12 for men. The campus recently completed its four-year reclassification to NCAA Division I status and became an official member of the Big West Conference, joining sister UC campuses Santa Barbara, Irvine and Riverside, along with five other schools.

We treat Aggie student-athletes as students first. The goal of promoting a positive educational experience has been achieved with considerable success at UC Davis. Approximately 800 student-athletes majoring in 87 different undergraduate programs and three graduate programs compete for UC Davis. As student-athletes, participants are expected to make academic progress in their major. Aggie coaches, most of whom are professional educators, possess a strong concern for their students' abilities in the classroom and are proud of graduation and retention rates. Student-athletes graduate at a rate comparable to that of the general student population and regularly earn advanced degrees after graduation.

Ingrained at UC Davis is the belief that excellence in competition depends not only on the skill of the participant, but also on the student-athlete's character, preparation and commitment to the ideals of athletic competition. UC Davis has had three winners of the NCAA Woman of the Year award.

The new multi-use Aggie Stadium is our most recent state-of-the-art sports facility to open on campus, joining the Marya Welch Tennis Center, the James M. and Ann Dobbins Baseball Complex and the Ted and Rand Schaal Aquatics Center.
